PROJECT OVERVIEW

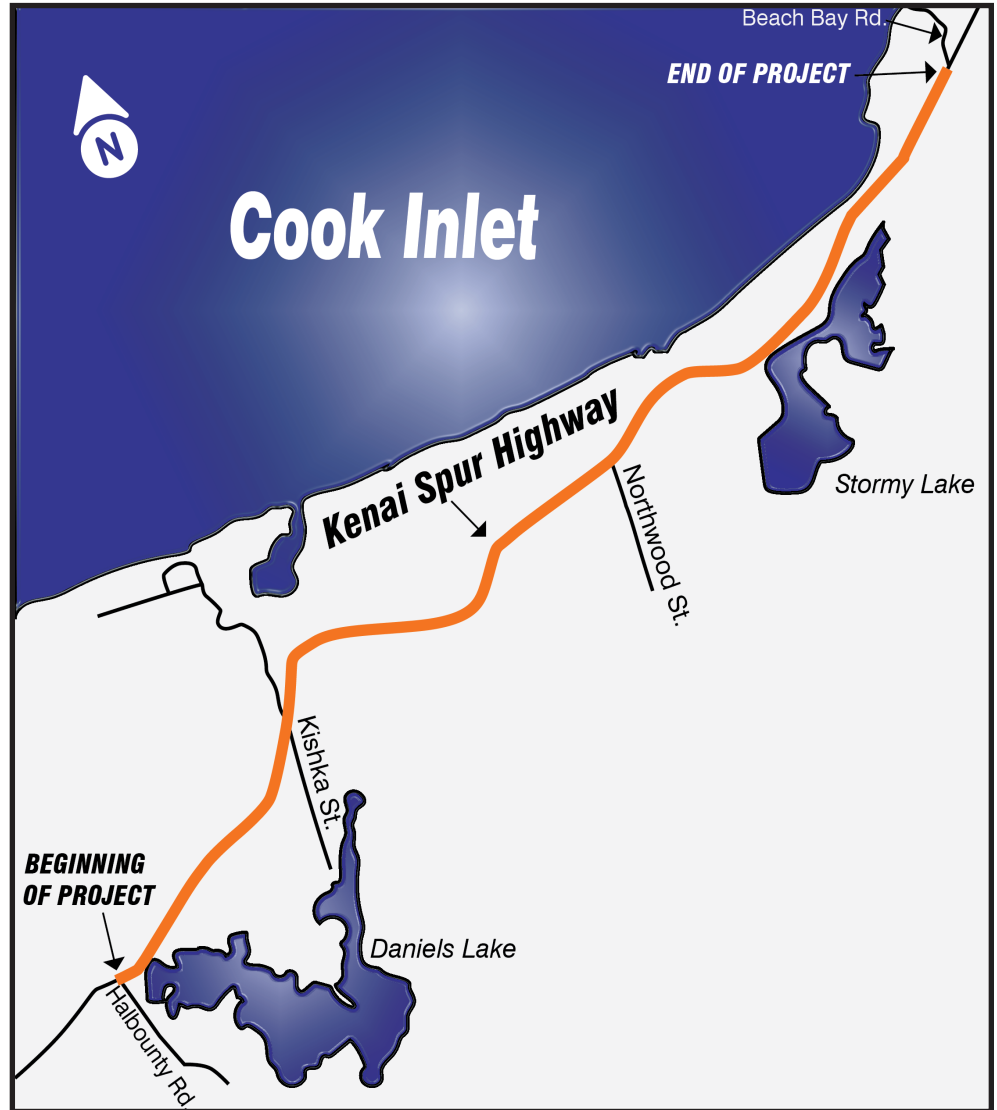
The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are proposing to resurface the Kenai Spur Highway between mileposts 29 and 38. Repaving will help preserve the roadbed and make it last longer. It will also make for a smoother drive. This project will include limited additional improvements like culvert replacements and vegetation clearing.

PURPOSE & NEED

The pavement shows considerable wear, and the intent of the project is to preserve and extend the service life of the facility.

PROPOSED WORK

- Resurfacing
- Dig-outs
- Drainage improvements
- Roadside hardware
- Signing & striping
- Utility relocations
- Vegetation clearing
- Minor bridge repairs
- Safety improvements
