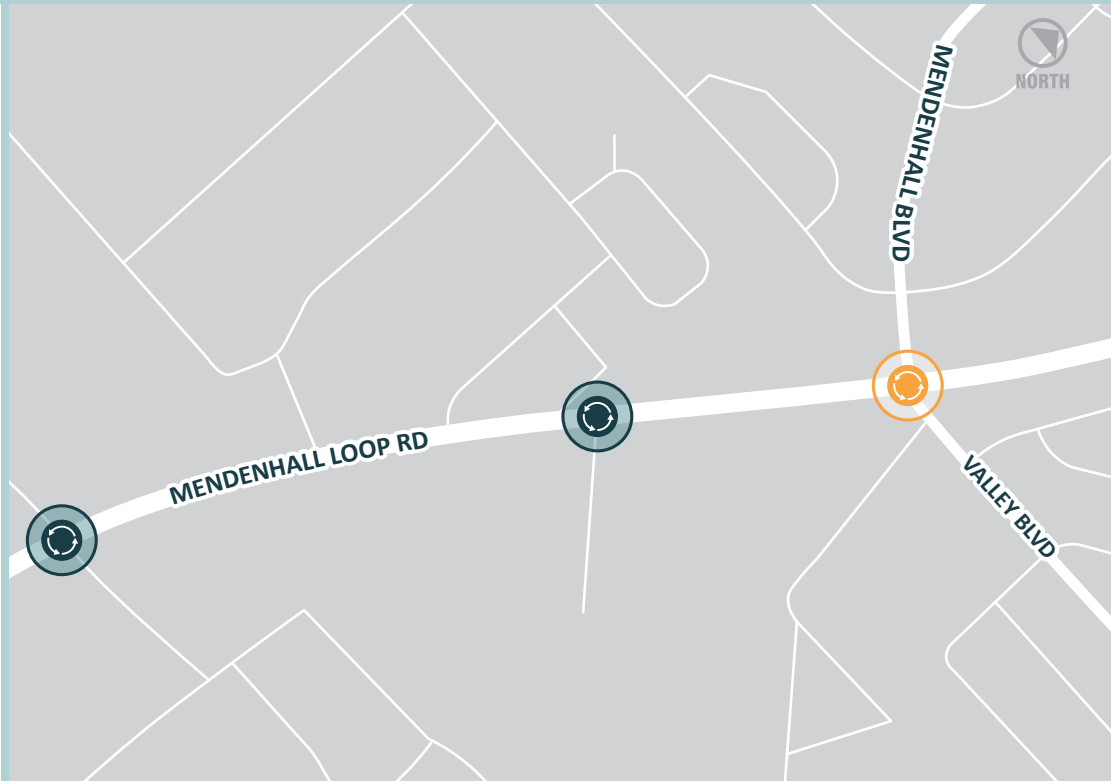
The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is proposing to construct a single lane roundabout at the intersection of Mendenhall Loop Road (Loop Road), Mendenhall Boulevard, and Valley Boulevard in the Mendenhall Valley Area in Juneau, Alaska.

The proposed project would:

- Replace the existing signalized intersection with a single-lane roundabout.
- Widen the footprint of the intersection, acquiring adjacent right-of-way (ROW).
- Evaluate locations of bus pullouts.
- Add splitter islands to separate lanes on approach to the intersection.
- Interact with drainage structures.
